#### **Old Business**

- Rulemaking
  - Specific parts of the new rule draft were discussed:
    - Application fee potentially moving to statute.
    - Expired registrations eliminating 2 year "grace period." Discussed how that will work and what that will mean for RS credential holders and delegated agencies.
    - Touched on the three tracks of Initial Registration.
    - Discussed the Definition of Field of Environment Health and the list that defines it.
      Lynn suggested we add "Body Art" and "Nuisance Investigation and Abatement"
      since Bloomington has environmental health professional that do this. Peggy
      suggested we add "Cannabis Management" Duane suggested we add "Retail
      Tobacco."
      - The council unanimously voted to add Body Art, Nuisance Investigation and Abatement, Cannabis Management and Retail Tobacco to the Definition of Field of Environment Health.
    - Discussed holding future 'special meetings' outside of the regularly scheduled quarterly meetings. The council agreed that this should be added to the new rule.
