

HuBERT Report Name: **Weight Status of Women and Children Greater Than 2 Years (BMI) OPR032**

Report Topics: Nutrition, Weight

Frequency: Monthly

Access/Where to find: HuBERT AgencyEOM site: EOM Optional Nutrition Reports folder (“Weight Status.PDF”) and StateEOM FTP site: EOM Optional Nutrition Reports folder (“Weight Status.PDF” and “Weight Status.xls”)

Description: This report is run during the End-of-Month (EOM) process. It counts participants, and calculates percentages, within weight status ranges for each local agency, grantee, and the state. Clinics are not displayed.

Criteria and Filters:

- Participants must have received benefits for the report month (Some-BF women > 6 months postpartum are included and counted at the agency at which they were originally certified).
- Children must be at least 24 months old and have their measurement taken while standing.
- Percentiles are determined using the CDC 2000 BMI/Age growth charts.

Some possible purposes for this report:

- To describe the WIC population served by your local agency.
- To monitor changes in weight status of WIC participants in local agencies and grantees.
- To plan and share information with community partners to address Overweight and Obesity.
- To compare an agency’s rates to national goals.

Output Options:

- within the FTP site: Optional Nutrition Reports folder
 - Weight Status.PDF is approximately 60 pages in length and displays the totals for each local agency, each grantee, and the state totals.
 - Weight Status.xls displays a spreadsheet (in StateEOM site only)
