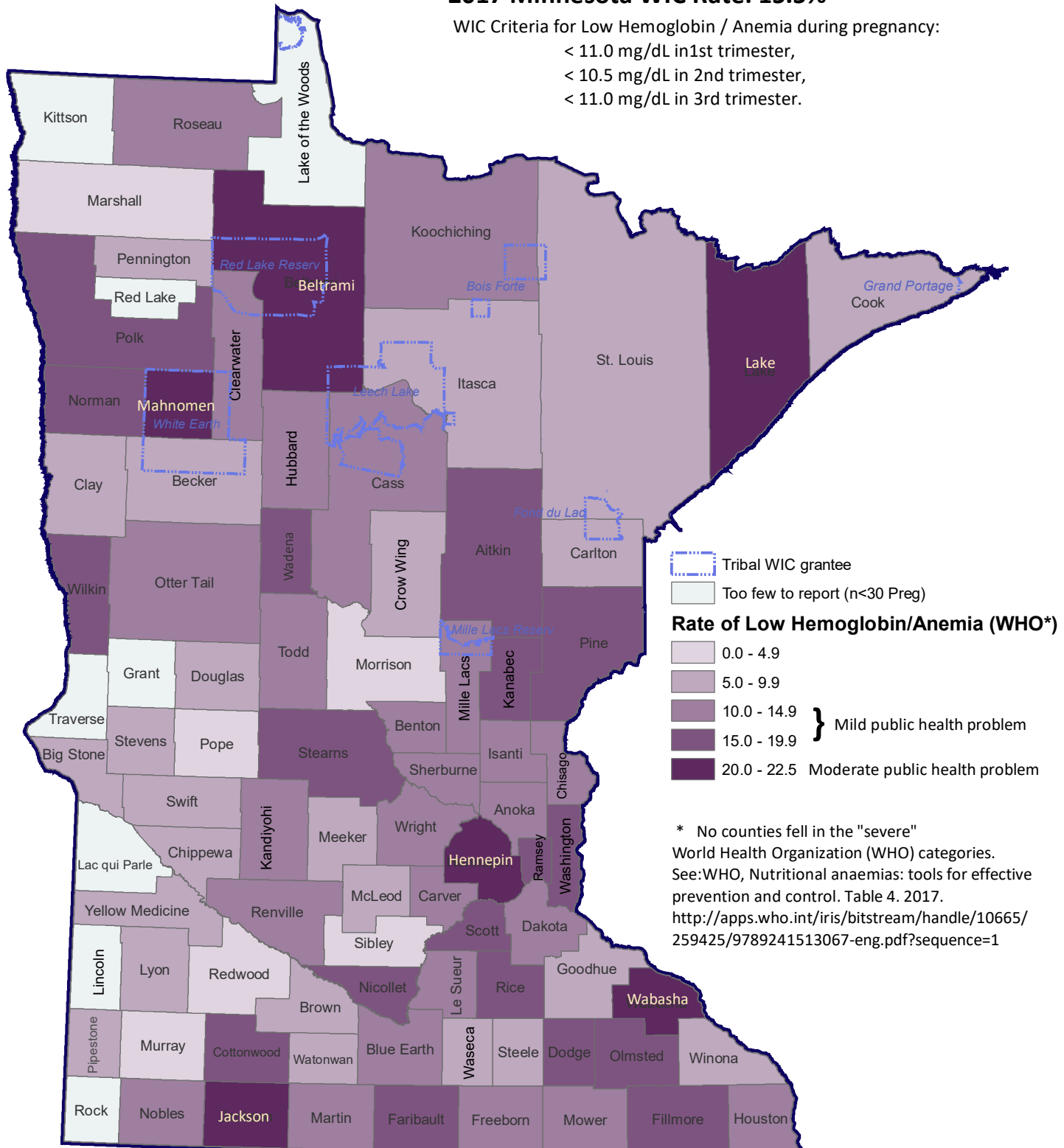


Iron Status during Pregnancy by County of Residence, 2017

2017 Minnesota WIC Rate: 15.5%

WIC Criteria for Low Hemoglobin / Anemia during pregnancy:

- < 11.0 mg/dL in 1st trimester,
- < 10.5 mg/dL in 2nd trimester,
- < 11.0 mg/dL in 3rd trimester.
