

Grantee Referral List for Mental Health Cultural Community Continuing Education Grant Program

The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH), Office of Rural Health and Primary Care (ORHPC) solicited proposals from post-secondary educational institutions and private training entities who are approved as continuing education providers by mental health licensing boards through the Mental Health Cultural Community Continuing Education Grant Program (MHCCCE).

The following trainers were selected through a competitive process, to offer free trainings to eligible students who wish to become board-recognized supervisors to mental health practitioners seeking licensure.

Professionals eligible for the free training must hold one of the licenses listed below and must be from a community of color and/or an underrepresented community as defined in Subd. 20 of [Sec. 148E.010 MN Statutes](#) as:

"Underrepresented community" means a group that is not represented in the majority with respect to race, ethnicity, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity, or physical ability.
