In anticipation of COVID-19 products being added to the federal VFC contract, you can now submit requests for 2025-26 MnVFC COVID-19 products in MIIC. Submit your request in MIIC by clicking “request special event vaccine” and selecting the event titled “2025-26 MnVFC COVID-19 Vaccines.”

We will ship vaccine as soon as it is made available to us by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Due to shelf-life constraints of the new products, only submit requests for the doses you expect to need for a few weeks at a time. You will be able to submit additional requests when you need more doses.

We encourage you to review your MnVFC COVID-19 vaccines administered last year to help guide your ordering this year. You can access this data in MIIC using the Doses Administered by Eligibility Report (DAER) feature. To ensure equitable access early in the season, you may receive your request in multiple shipments. Please keep this in mind when planning vaccination events. We plan to transition MnVFC COVID-19 vaccine to the routine ordering form later in the season. We will communicate ahead of this transition.
