Re: Infant Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) Immunization Season Ends Today

The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) extended the date for use of RSV monoclonal antibody (mAb) products through April 30. As the seasonal immunization period ends, Beyfortus (nirsevimab) and Enflonsia (clesrovimab) have been removed from the MnVFC ordering form.

Some doses in the field might not expire this season and can still be used in the fall. Check expiration dates and store any unused doses in the refrigerator to be used next season. Any doses that will expire before next season should be stored until their expiration date then reported as nonviable in the Minnesota Immunization Information System (MIIC).
